

Guidelines for Formal Dresses

Dresses must meet the following guidelines:

1. Strapless dresses are not allowed. However, clear straps may be added to a strapless dress. A dress with one strap or more is acceptable. The intent is that the strap holds up the dress and that the dress lies next to the skin.
2. Low-cut fronts, keyholes, cutouts or anything that reveals cleavage is not allowed. The back should be no lower than the natural waist area. This needs to be confined to the back area (not the side) and maintain modesty.
3. Sheer/ see-through material is considered the same as bare skin.
4. Overly form-fitting dresses are not allowed. Dresses should fall straight off the hips/bottom. Dress length and/or slits must be no higher than 4” above the middle of the knee.

The committee will be available to view dresses from 3:05-3:45 in the library on the following Wednesdays: **Mar 17, Mar 31, Apr 7, Apr 14, Apr 21, Apr 28**. Please make sure you have the **appropriate undergarments** with your dress.

If you have a question about whether a dress will fit the guidelines, you may text a photo of the dress to Mrs. Adams (256-288-6842) or Mrs. Brock (256-282-1648). Dresses may be “conditionally approved” over texts but must still be brought to the school and tried on in person to the committee for final approval. Girls attending prom from other schools must also have their dresses approved.
